Introduction

Welcome to the Language Book Reader App. LanguageBookReader is designed to make learning a language easier than ever by allowing the student to imitate a native speaker using the *Speak and Learn* technology. It has been proven that a person is readily able to understand what he can meaningfully say himself, if the correlation between the way he hears it and the way he says it is reasonably similar. Probably the more similar, the greater the comprehension. Basically what this is saying that: If you can say it fluently, you will understand it when you hear it.



Repeat and Learn

This app is designed with this concept in mind. It forces a student to authentically manipulate the sounds, sequences and patterns of a language through guided imitation. A word or phrase is repeated by the student until the student is able to fluently say the complete phrase. Repeating the speaker's words out loud forms the basis of learning the language. A person will generally never be able to speak a foreign language fluently without the careful imitation of the sounds he hears. Taking completed sentences and paragraphs and breaking them up into smaller phrases that is carefully repeated leads to the concept of Repeat and Learn. A person being able to speak a phrase or sentence fluently generally leads to full comprehension


